Dear Mr. Fitzpatrick,

This correspondence is in regards to your request to appear before the Monroe County Grand Jury on September 3, 2009. You were given the opportunity to present evidence of criminal act(s) committed against you to a committee of three people from the Monroe County Grand Jury. By way of this process, a determination would be made as to whether the full Grand Jury would hear evidence of a crime being committed against your person.

The panel of three jurors heard your information on charges of forgery and treason. The charge of forgery by your attorney (JAG officer) was found to be outside the statute of limitations and not occurring within the boundary of Monroe County, Tennessee. As to the second charge, which was the charge of treason against President Barack Obama (aka Barry Soetoro in your affidavit), the jurors consulted the Tennessee Code Annotated for the definition of treason under Tennessee law. Treason as defined is an act of war on the United States of America. Based on Tennessee code as defined, no evidence of such actions has occurred within the boundary of Monroe County, Tennessee.

As a result of their deliberations, by way of this letter I am informing you that they have recommended you not be allowed to appear before the full Monroe County Grand Jury on the evidence presented for these crimes.
